Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Golden, Maltese, Marchi, Mendez, Padavan and Velella, S.4185, and Assembly Members Abbate, M. Cohen and Lavelle, A.7167-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to providing accidental disability retirement benefits for certain transit authority members of the New York city employees' retirement system"; and
