

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on September 17, 1999 its decision dated September 8, 1999 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the Department of Business Services, for the disposition to the Economic Development Corporation of one (1) city-owned property pursuant to zoning, located at 738 Third Avenue (Block 644/part of Lot 1), Borough of Brooklyn (ULURP No. C 990519 PPK) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(3) of the City Charter;
