By Council Members Baez, Comrie, Gerson, Jackson, Martinez, Serrano, Stewart and Monserrate; also Council Member Boyland A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the City of New York, in relation to the placement of bus stops.

Be it in enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subchapter 2 of chapter 1 of title 19 of the administrative code of the city of New York is hereby amended by adding a new section 19-171 to read as follows:

§19-171. a. For purposes of this section, the following terms shall have the following meanings: 1. "Blockface" shall mean the area of sidewalk on each side of a street spanning from one intersection to the next.

- 2. "Intersection" shall have the meaning set forth in section 120 of the vehicle and traffic law.
- b. Except as otherwise required by state or federal law or regulation, no more than seventy feet or twenty-five percent of any blockface, whichever is greater, shall in the aggregate be officially designated as a bus stop.
 - §2. This local law shall take effect one hundred and eighty days after its enactment into law.
