Whereas, a bill has been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Committee on Rules, A.11513, "AN ACT to amend the tax law, in relation to authorizing any city having a population of one million or more to provide a partial exemption from the mortgage recording tax and to provide certain credits against the personal income tax of any such city".
