A Local Law to amend the New York city charter, in relation to the board of correction's access to body-worn camera records

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph 2 of subdivision c of section 626 of the New York city charter, is amended to read as follows

- 2. The inspection of all books, records, documents, and papers of the department <u>including direct and</u> real-time remote access to the body-worn camera system and the ability to retain physical and electronic copies.
 - § 2. This local law takes effect immediately.
