Whereas, Such health hazards created by the excessive noise level of the Concorde in conjunction with the advanced age, physical deterioration and questionable airworthiness of the existing fleet of Concorde create an untenable and immediately hazardous threat to the communities surrounding the Kennedy International Airport, the communities over which such aircraft fly and passengers and crew travelling aboard the Concorde; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, that the New York City Council calls upon the Federal Aviation Administration to permanently ground and discontinue operations of all supersonic Concorde airplanes.
