A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to civil penalties for violations of the littering law.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision two of section 16-118 of the administrative code of the city of New York, is amended by adding a new paragraph c to read as follows:

c. No notice of violation of paragraph a of this subdivision shall be issued to any owner, lessee, tenant, occupant or person in charge of any solely residential building or premises where the material for which the violation was written consists of a handbill, circular, card, booklet, placard, menu or advertising matter of any type.

§2. This local law shall take effect thirty days after enactment.
