A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the distribution of information regarding summer meals

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision b of section 21-979 of the administrative code of the city of New York, as added

by local law number 4 for the year 2018, is amended to read as follows:

b. No later than June 1, 2018, and annually thereafter no later than June 1, the department shall make

available information regarding summer meals including, but not limited to, locations where such meals will be

available, the times and dates during which such meals will be available and any guidelines regarding eligibility

for such meals. Such information shall be:

1. [posted] Posted on the department's website, the website of any city agency collaborating with the

department and the website of the 311 customer service center; [and]

2. [distributed] <u>Distributed</u> to council members, borough presidents, community boards, community

education councils, parent associations and parent teacher associations[.]; and

3. Provided to every student, and shall include the three locations nearest to each student's school of

attendance where such meals will be available, at the time such information is provided.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 90 days after it becomes law.
