RESOLUTION NO. 1487

Resolution approving the site plan for a new, approximately 472-Seat Primary School Facility to be located at 57-02 to 57-08 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 39-12 to 39-16 58<sup>th</sup> Street (Tax Block 1228, Lots 48, 52, 57, 58, 60, and 61), Woodside, Borough of Queens (Non-ULURP No. 20125427 SCQ; Preconsidered L.U. No. 663).

WHEREAS, the New York City School Construction Authority submitted to the Council on August 15, 2012, a site plan dated August 15, 2012, pursuant to Section 1732 of the New York State Public Authorities Law for a new, approximately 472-Seat Primary School Facility, known as P.S. 339-Queens, to be located at 57-02 to 57-08 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 39-12 to 39-16 58<sup>th</sup> Street (Tax Block 1228, Lots 48, 52, 57, 58, 60, and 61) in the Woodside section of Queens, Community Board No. 2, Borough of Queens, Community School District No. 30 (the "Site Plan");

WHEREAS, the Site Plan is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 1732 of the New York State Public Authorities Law;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Site Plan on August 20, 2012;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental issues and the Negative Declaration issued on August 13, 2012 (SEQR Project Number 13-003); and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Site Plan;

RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the action described herein will have no significant effect on the environment.

Pursuant to Section 1732 of the Public Authorities Law, the Council approves the Site Plan.
