Resolution approving with modifications the decision of the City Planning Commission on ULURP No. C 030027 PPK, the disposition of four (4) city-owned properties located at 735 Dean Street (Block 1130/Lot 53), 1777 Pacific Street (Block 1336/Lot 63), 65 Utica Avenue (Block 1337/Lot 4), and 63 A Utica Avenue (Block 1337/Lot 5), Brooklyn (L.U. No. 391).

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on February 26, 2003 its decision dated February 19, 2003 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, for the disposition of four (4) city-owned properties pursuant to zoning, located at 735 Dean Street (Block 1130/Lot 53), 1777 Pacific Street (Block 1336/Lot 63), 65 Utica Avenue (Block 1337/Lot 4), and 63 A Utica Avenue (Block 1337/Lot 5), Community District 8, Borough of Brooklyn (ULURP No. C 030027 PPK) (the "Application");
