Title: Resolution calling upon Allianz, BASF, Bayer, BMW, Commerzbank, DaimlerChrysler, Degussa-Huels, Deutsche Bank, Henkel, Hoechst, Mannesmann, Siemens, ThyssenKrupp, Veba, Viag, Volkswagen and the many other companies who utilized slave and forced labor in its factories during World War II to compensate such survivors with an amount commensurate to the pain and suffering endured by them.
