Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an enclosed sidewalk café located at 533 Hudson Street, Borough of Manhattan (20075254 TCM; L.U. No. 628).

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on November 1, 2007 its approval dated November 1, 2007 of the petition of BacBars Group LLC, d/b/a Bayard's Ale House, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an enclosed sidewalk café located at 533 Hudson Street, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-225 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
