**Title:** Resolution calling on the United States Senate and the President to oppose H.R. 822, known as the "National Right-to-Carry Reciprocity Act of 2011," which would allow a resident from one state who has a license to carry a concealed handgun to lawfully carry his or her handgun into a different state, regardless of the licensing eligibility standards in the other state.
