## By Council Members Lander, Dromm, James and Koo

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to penalties for obstruction of sidewalks and courtyards.

### Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-136 of chapter one of title 19 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by amending subdivision b to read as follows:

- b. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, directly or indirectly, to use any portion of a sidewalk or courtyard, established by law, between building line and then the curb line for the parking, storage, display or sale of motor vehicles.
- 2. A first or second violation of paragraph one of this subdivision shall be subject to a fine of not less than two hundred sixty-five dollars.
  - 3. A third or subsequent violation of paragraph one of this subdivision shall be subject to a fine of not

less than five hundred fifteen dollars.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect sixty days after its enactment.
