**Title:** Resolution calling on the New York State Legislature to enact S3644/A2012, and for the Governor to sign the legislation into law. The legislation gives authority to the New York Police Department to enforce Vehicle and Traffic Law Section 1146, even if the police officer was not present at the time of the crash, as long as the officer has reasonable cause to believe the violation was committed by the driver.
