WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 8, 2012 its approval dated June 1, 2012 of the petition of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue Restaurant Group LLC, d/b/a Tasca, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 130-138 Seventh Avenue South, Community District 2, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
