WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on June 22, 2012 its approval dated June 22, 2012 of the petition of Aura, LLC, d/b/a Micky Spillane's Kitchen, for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 350 West 49th Street, Community District 4, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");
