WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on September 13, 2013 its decision dated September 11, 2013 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the Administration for Children's Services (ACS) and the Department of Citywide Administrative Services (DCAS), for the acquisition of property located at 200 Central Avenue (Block 3228, Lot 20) (the "Site"), Community District 4, (ULURP No. C 130126 PQQ) Borough of Brooklyn, for continued use as a child care center (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(3) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Decision and Application on October 2, 2013;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Decision and Application;

WHEREAS, this application was determined to be a Type II action which requires no further environmental review;
