A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the New York City Police Department to report noise complaints on a quarterly basis.

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one of title 14 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to add a new section 14-155 to read as follows:

§14-155. Noise complaint reporting.

a. Definitions. For the purposes of this section the following terms shall have the following meanings:

1. "Noise complaint" shall mean a complaint made via the 311 system that arises from the noise of

## neighbors, clubs and bars, parks, stores and businesses, streets and sidewalks, and motor vehicles and

#### motorcycles.

b. Report of total noise complaints. The department shall submit to the council on a quarterly basis, a report of the total number of noise complaints received within the quarter, disaggregated by precinct.

c. Report of individual noise complaints. The department shall submit to the council on a quarterly

basis a report listing each individual complaint received within the quarter disaggregated by precinct and zip

code within each precinct. The report for each individual complaint shall include, at a minimum:

1. the time and date the complaint was made;

2. the specific location complained of;

3. a description of the complaint;

- 4. whether or not the department responded to the complaint;
- 3. the time the department responded to the complaint; and

4. the disposition, if any, reached by the department.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
