A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the distance between parking signs.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subchapter 2 of chapter 1 of title 19 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to add a new section 19-175.5 to read as follows:

§ 19-175.5 Distance between parking signs. On every block longer than two hundred feet, the department shall post a sign indicating parking, standing or stopping regulations every one hundred feet or less.

For purposes of this section, “block” shall mean a stretch of roadway that connects two intersections.

§2. This local law shall take effect ninety days after its enactment into law.
