WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on December 22, 2015 its approval dated December 14, 2015 of the petition of Becaf, LLC, d/b/a Poco NYC, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 33 Avenue B, Community District 3, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226 (g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, by letter dated January 25, 2016, and submitted to the City Council on January 26, 2016, the Applicant withdrew the Application submitted to the Department of Consumer Affairs for recommendation for approval for the revocable consent.
