A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the New York City Police Department to report on arrests of individuals under eighteen years of age.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision a of section 14-150 of the administrative code of the city of New York is

amended by adding a new paragraph 9 to read as follows:

City Council

9. A report of the total number of individuals under eighteen years of age arrested by Department

personnel, and for each arrest (i) the charge, whether penal law or other section of law; (ii) the age of the

individual arrested; (iii) the race of the individual arrested; (iv) the precinct of the arrest; and (v) whether or not

the location of the arrest corresponds to the address of a school run by the Department of Education.

§2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
