A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring council approval before the removal of a statue on city property

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 2 of title 4 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 4-210 to read as follows:

§ 4-210 Removal of statues on city property. a. Definitions. For purposes of this section, the term

"statue" means a three-dimensional sculpture, carving or other piece of public art depicting one or more

persons that commemorates one or more persons or a historical event and is not a temporary exhibition.

b. No statue on property owned or controlled by the city may be permanently removed without at least

the majority affirmative vote of all the council members.

§ 2. This local law becomes effective immediately after it is submitted for the approval of the qualified electors of the city at the next general election held after its enactment and approved by a majority of such electors voting thereon.
