A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to bulletproof vests used by the New York city police department

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 10 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by

adding a new section 10-179 to read as follows:

§ 10-179 Bulletproof vests. The department shall only utilize bulletproof vests that are:

a. Covered by their manufacturer's warranty;

b. Have not been in use for more than five years;

- c. Have not been struck by any projectile from a firearm, or any similar projectile;
- d. Fit their user properly in such a manner that they provide the protection for which they were

designed;

e. Meet the standard for ballistic resistance classification IIIA as determined by the national institute of

justice or any successor national institute of justice standard; and

f. Are not damaged in any other way that would substantially affect performance;

§2. This local law takes effect 6 months after it becomes law.
