A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the taxi and limousine commission to create a fine and civil penalty payment plan.

Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

City Council

Section 1. Chapter five of title 19 of the administrative code of the city of New York amended by adding

a new section 19-548 to read as follows:

§ 19-548 Payment Plans. The commission shall provide by rule for the installment payment of any fines

or civil penalties returnable before the commission or an administrative tribunal of the commission owed by

any person who violates any of the provisions of this chapter or any rule or regulation issued thereunder.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, the commission shall not suspend any drivers license

issued by the commission solely for non-payment of any fines or civil penalties where the holder is in

compliance with any terms and conditions related to such installment payment.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect 90 days after its enactment into law, except that the Taxi and Limousine Commission shall take all necessary action, including the promulgation of rules, prior to such effective date.
