## By Council Member Rosenthal

A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring the implementation of technology to allow traffic enforcement agents to issue idling tickets through their handheld computers

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 1 of title 14 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended by adding

a new section 14-118.3 to read as follows:

§ 14-118.3 Handheld computers. Handheld computers used by the department to enforce laws, rules and

regulations relating to parking violations shall be capable of issuing notices of violation returnable to the office

of administrative trials and hearings alleging violations of the engine idling restrictions of section 24-163 of this

code and rules promulgated thereto.
