WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental issues, including the negative declaration issued October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018 (CEQR No. 18DCP182K), which included (E) designations to avoid the potential for significant adverse impacts related to air quality or noise (E-507) (the “Negative Declaration”).

RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the action described herein will have no significant impact on the environment as set forth in the (E) Designation (E-507) and Negative Declaration.
