**Resolution approving the petition for a renewal consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 444 3rd Avenue, Borough of Manhattan (Non-ULURP No. 20195720 TCM; L.U. No. 530).**

WHEREAS, the Department of Consumer Affairs filed with the Council on August 23, 2019 its approval dated August 13, 2019 of the petition of E & R U.S. Ventures LLC d/b/a Hummus Kitchen, for a renewal consent to continue, operate, and use an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 444 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Borough of Manhattan, Community District 6 (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(f) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on September 18th, 2019; and
