A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to requiring information related to tree ownership be shared via 311

## Be it enacted by the Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 3 of title 23 of the administrative code of the city of New York is amended to add a

new section 23-304 to read as follows:

§23-304 Tree inquiries. a. The department of information technology and telecommunications in

coordination with the department of parks and recreation shall make available on the 311 citizen service center

website, telephone, and mobile device platforms for each request submitted relating to a tree where a city

agency or office is the owner of such tree:

1. Within one day of submission of such request, the city agency or office that owns such tree;

2. Within three days of submission of such request, whether such tree poses an immediate health or

safety risk as confirmed by the department of parks and recreation; and

3. Within seven days of the submission of such request, the resolution of such request along with the

contact information of the city agency or office that owns such tree.

§ 2. This local law takes effect 120 days after it becomes law. IS LS #11,478 10/16/19
