Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 33-02 Broadway (19995425 TCQ; L.U. No. 591).

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation filed with the Council on November 4, 1999 its approval of the petition of Café Kolonaki, Inc. (the "Applicant"), for a revocable consent to establish, maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 33-02 Broadway, Borough of Queens (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on December 13, 1999; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has indicated that it shall modify its Petition to seven (7) tables and fourteen (14) chairs;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Petition;
