Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Marchi, S.4008-A and Assembly Member Vitaliano, A.7259-A, "AN ACT in relation to allowing prior service credit for Joseph K. Mayrose for service as a New York city police department trainee"; and
