Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Maltese and Hannon, S.764-A, and Assembly Member Seminero, A.1271-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law, in relation to employee contributions to the twenty year improved benefit retirement programs for New York city correction members"; and

Whereas, The enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
