Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senators Maltese and Hannon, S.771-A, and Assembly Member Seminero, A.1270-A, "AN ACT to amend the retirement and social security law and the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to the permitting certain New York city correction members to borrow from their accumulated member contributions and to repeal certain provisions of the retirement and social security law relating thereto"; and

Whereas, The enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Council of the City of New York, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2 of Article 9 of the Constitution of the State of New York, does hereby request the New York State Legislature to enact into law the aforesaid pending bills.
