WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on April 24, 2000 its decision dated April 18, 2000 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the New York City Department of Housing Preservation and Development for the disposition of city-owned property, within the Mott Haven East Urban Renewal Area located at 830-50 E. 149th Street (Block 2582/Lot 65), Borough of the Bronx (ULURP No. C 000231 HDX) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Application is related to ULURP Application number C 000230 HUX (L.U. No. 635), an urban renewal plan amendment;

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(3) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Application and Decision on May 31, 2000;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental issues and the Negative Declaration, issued on July 6, 1999 (CEQR No. 99HPD10X); and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Decision and Application;
