WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on May 4, 2000 its decision dated May 3, 2000 (the "Decision") on the application submitted pursuant to Section 197-c of the New York City Charter by the Department of Citywide Administrative Services, for the disposition of four (4) city-owned properties pursuant to zoning, located at 446 and 448 West 167th Street (Block 2111/Lots 99 and 97) and 2260 and 2262 Amsterdam Avenue (Block 2129/Lots 52 and 50), Borough of Manhattan (ULURP No. C 000040 PPM) (the "Application");
