Whereas, bills have been introduced in the New York State Legislature by Senator Marchi, S.1281-A, and Assembly Members Vitaliano, Seminerio, Clark, Connelly, M. Cohen, Colton, and Seddio, A.1981-A, "AN ACT to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to establishing a variable supplements fund for members of the New York city employees' retirement system"; and

Whereas, The enactment of the above State Legislation requires the concurrence of the Council of the City of New York as the local legislative body; now, therefore, be it
