WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on April 11, 2000 a copy of its designation dated March 28, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the Croton Aqueduct West 119th Street Gatehouse, located at 432-434 West 119th Street, (a.k.a. 1191-1195 Amsterdam Avenue), Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 1962, Lot 35, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on June 5, 2000, its report on the Designation dated May 31, 2000 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on June 20, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
