Resolution affirming the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of the Riverside Church located at 490-498 Riverside Drive and 81 Claremont Avenue, Manhattan, Designation List No. 313, LP-2037 (L.U. No. 798; 20005436 HKM; N 000607 HKM).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on May 26, 2000 a copy of its designation dated May 16, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the Riverside Church located at 490-498 Riverside Drive and 81 Claremont Avenue, Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 1991, Lot 32 in part, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on July 14, 2000, its report on the Designation dated July 12, 2000 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on August 21, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
