WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on May 26, 2000 a copy of its designation dated May 16, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the Children's Aid Society, Tompkins Square Lodging House, located at 295 East 8th Street (aka 127-129 Avenue B), Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 391, Lot 1, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on July 14, 2000, its report on the Designation dated July 12, 2000 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on August 21, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
