WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on June 12, 2000 a copy of its designation dated May 30, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the Ridgewood Savings Bank, Forest Hills Branch located at 107-55 Queens Boulevard, Borough of Queens, as a landmark and Block 2216, Lot 1, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on July 27, 2000, its report on the Designation dated July 26, 2000 (the "Report"):
