WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on June 30, 2000 a copy of its designation dated June 20, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the Russell Sage Foundation Building and Annex located at 122-130 East 22nd Street (a.k.a. 4-8 Lexington Avenue), Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 877, Lot 74, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 30, 2000 its report on the Designation dated August 23, 2000 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on September 18, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

## RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
