WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on July 7, 2000 a copy of its designation dated June 27, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the Broad Exchange Building located at 25 Broad Street (aka 25-33 Broad Street and 44-60 Exchange Place), Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 25, Lot 19, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 30, 2000 its report on the Designation dated August 23, 2000 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on October 10, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
