

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1594

Resolution approving the decision of the City Planning Commission on ULURP No. C 000310 ZMR, a Zoning Map Change (L.U. No. 848).

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission filed with the Council on September 25, 2000 its decision dated September 20, 2000 (the "Decision"), on the application submitted by the Staten Island Borough President, pursuant to Sections 197-c and 201 of the New York City Charter, for an amendment to the Zoning Map (ULURP No. C 000310 ZMR) (the "Application");

WHEREAS, the Decision is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 197-d(b)(1) of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Decision and Application on October 10, 2000;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Decision and Application; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental issues and the Negative Declaration, issued on June 26, 2000 (CEQR No. 00DCP043R);

RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the action described herein will have no significant effect on the environment.

Pursuant to Sections 197-d and 200 of the City Charter and on the basis of the Decision and Application, the Council approves the Decision.
