WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on July 7, 2000 a copy of its designation dated June 27, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the 120th Police Precinct Station House (Former 66th Police Precinct Station House and Headquarters), located at 78 Richmond Terrace (Block 9, Lot 28), Borough of Staten Island, as a landmark and Block 9, Lot 28, as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on August 30, 2000 its report on the Designation dated August 23, 2000 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on October 10, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
