Resolution No. 1625

Resolution authorizing the filing of applications for state assistance payments for municipal recycling projects within the City of New York and the signing of the associated state contract under the appropriate laws of New York State.

By Council Members Berman, Malave-Dilan, Reed, Fiala, Golden, Oddo and Stabile (by request of the Mayor); also Council Members Leffler, Marshall, Michels and Wooten.

Whereas, The State of New York provides financial assistance for municipal recycling projects; and

Whereas, Article 56 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law ("ECL") and any rules and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto require a resolution to be adopted by the governing body of a municipality to authorize applications for such state assistance payments; and

Whereas, The City of New York has examined and duly considered the applicable laws of the City and State of New York and deems it to be in the public interest to file one or more than one application for such financial assistance payments; and

Whereas, The New York City Department of Sanitation has prepared applications to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation ("DEC") for state assistance payments to the New York City Department of Sanitation for such projects, which are also identified in the list attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by this reference as Attachment No. 1; and

Whereas, If the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation approves one or more than one of the applications for state assistance payments for such projects, it is necessary that a contract by and between the State of New York and the City of New York be executed in connection with such state assistance payments for each approved project application; and

Whereas, The New York City Department of Sanitation is the agency charged with the management of the recycling program and projects of the City of New York; now therefore, be it

Resolved by the Council of the City of New York that:

- The filing of applications for such state assistance payments for the projects specified in Attachment No. 1 in the form required by the State of New York, in conformity with the applicable laws of the State of New York, including all understandings and assurances required by said applications, is hereby authorized;
- Kevin P. Farrell, as Commissioner of the New York City Department of Sanitation, or his successor(s), is hereby authorized and directed as the official representative of the City of New York to submit such applications for funds to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation in accordance with the provisions of Title 4 of the Clean Water/Clean Air Bond Act of 1996 (Title 4 of ECL Article 56) for the projects, in amounts not to exceed the amounts specified therein; to act in connection with such applications for grants of state

assistance payments, including the provision of such additional information as may be required; and upon approval of any said applications by New York State for such projects, to enter into and execute a state assistance contract with the State for such financial assistance to the New York City Department of Sanitation for each said approval application;

3. Five certified copies of this Resolution shall be prepared for forwarding to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation.
