Resolution affirming the designation by the Landmarks Preservation Commission of the Whitehall Building located at 17 Battery Place (Block 15/Lot 7501), Designation List No. 317, LP-2056 (L.U. No. 944; 20015090 HKM; N 010183 HKM).

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on October 30, 2000 a copy of its designation dated October 17, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the Whitehall Building located at 17 Battery Place (a.k.a. 1-17 West Street), Borough of Manhattan, as a landmark and Block 15/Lot 7501 as its landmark site pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on December 18, 2000, its report on the Designation dated December 13, 2000 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on January 9, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;

RESOLVED:

Pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter, and on the basis of the information and materials contained in the Designation and the Report, the Council affirms the Designation.
