THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK RESOLUTION NO. 1764

Resolution approving the site plan for Public School 268-Q, to be located at 175-02 Jamaica Avenue, Queens (Non-ULURP No. 20015118 SCQ; L.U. No. 977).

WHEREAS, the New York City School Construction Authority submitted to the Council on February 7, 2001, a site plan pursuant to Section 1732 of the New York State Public Authorities Law for a public school facility known as P.S. 268-Q, with a capacity of up to 704 seats to serve pre-kindergarten through fifth grades, Community School District 29, to be located at 175-02 Jamaica Avenue (Block 10215/Lots 1 and 9), Borough of Queens (the "Site Plan");

WHEREAS, the Site Plan is subject to review and action by the Council pursuant to Section 1732 of the New York State Public Authorities Law;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Site Plan on February 13, 2001;

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the relevant environmental issues and the Conditional Negative Declaration issued January 5, 2001 (SCA Project Number 01-002); and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Site Plan;

## RESOLVED:

The Council finds that the action described herein will have no significant effect on the environment; and

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Pursuant to Section 1732 of the Public Authorities Law, the Council approves the Site Plan.
