**Title:** A Local Law to amend the administrative code of the city of New York, in relation to extending the term of a plumbing or fire suppression piping contractor license and the renewal period to two years, requiring continuing education for a licensed master plumber and licensed fire suppression piping contractor to renew their license, expanding the scope of minor plumbing work that may be performed by unlicensed individuals and changing certain permitting practices.
