Resolution approving the petition for a revocable consent for an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 2986 Broadway, Manhattan (20015113 TCM; L.U. No. 1009).

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation filed with the Council on February 8, 2001 its approval of the petition of Deluxe on Broadway, Inc., d/b/a Deluxe, for a revocable consent to continue to maintain and operate an unenclosed sidewalk café located at 2986 Broadway, Borough of Manhattan (the "Petition"), pursuant to Section 20-226 of the New York City Administrative Code (the "Administrative Code");

WHEREAS, the Petition is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 20-226(g) of the Administrative Code;

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Petition on March 7, 2001; and
