WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Commission filed with the Council on November 22, 2000 a copy of its designation dated November 14, 2000 (the "Designation"), of the Downtown Athletic Club Building located at 19 West Street (a.k.a. 18-20 West Street and 28-32 Washington Street), Borough of Manhattan as a landmark and Block 15, Lot 19), as its landmark site, pursuant to Section 3020 of the New York City Charter;

WHEREAS, the Designation is subject to review by the Council pursuant to Section 3020 of the City Charter;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission submitted to the Council on February 14, 2001, its report on the Designation dated December 27, 2000 (the "Report");

WHEREAS, upon due notice, the Council held a public hearing on the Designation on March 6, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered the land use implications and other policy issues relating to the Designation;
